 <b>HEALTH &amp; CHILD DEVELOPMENT</b>	<b>HIGHEST QUALITY:</b> Uses a form recommended by pediatricians to check children's physical, social and emotional development, in addition to annual hearing and vision tests.
 <b>TEACHER TRAINING &amp; EDUCATION</b>	<b>HIGHEST QUALITY:</b> A bachelors degree in early childhood education and development and completes 21 hours of professional development annually.
 <b>POSITIVE TEACHER – CHILD INTERACTION</b>	<b>ACHIEVING QUALITY:</b> Has been rated on the quality of teacher-child interactions and has a plan for improvements.
 <b>ENVIRONMENT</b>	<b>ACHIEVING QUALITY:</b> Has been assessed on providing a safe, clean and enriching environment and has a plan for improvements.
