 CHILD OBSERVATION	ACHIEVING QUALITY: Observes child development and uses a state-approved tool to support children's learning and growth.
 HEALTH & CHILD DEVELOPMENT	HIGHEST QUALITY: Uses a form recommended by pediatricians to check children's physical, social and emotional development, in addition to annual hearing and vision tests.
 TEACHER TRAINING & EDUCATION	EXCEEDING QUALITY: An associate degree in early childhood education and development and completes 21 hours of professional development annually.
 POSITIVE TEACHER – CHILD INTERACTION	HIGHEST QUALITY: Scores highest on providing: emotional support; an organized classroom; consistent schedules and routines; interactions that build vocabulary, critical thinking skills and curiosity; lessons that include children's experiences and ideas.
