 <b>CHILD OBSERVATION</b>	<b>EXCEEDING QUALITY:</b> Evaluates children's learning and development, holds parent conferences, and uses a state-approved tool to help children learn.
 <b>HEALTH &amp; CHILD DEVELOPMENT</b>	<b>HIGHEST QUALITY:</b> Uses a form recommended by pediatricians to check children's physical, social and emotional development, in addition to annual hearing and vision tests.
 <b>TEACHER TRAINING &amp; EDUCATION</b>	<b>HIGHEST QUALITY:</b> A bachelors degree in early childhood education and development and completes 21 hours of professional development annually.
 <b>POSITIVE TEACHER – CHILD INTERACTION</b>	<b>HIGHEST QUALITY:</b> Scores highest on providing: emotional support; an organized classroom; consistent schedules and routines; interactions that build vocabulary, critical thinking skills and curiosity; lessons that include children's experiences and ideas.
