This program was rated in 2017 on the following:

 CHILD OBSERVATION	HIGHEST QUALITY Evaluates children's learning and development, holds parent conferences, and uses a state-approved tool to help children learn. Results are entered into a software program.
 HEALTH & CHILD DEVELOPMENT	HIGHEST QUALITY Uses a form recommended by pediatricians to check children's physical, social and emotional development, in addition to annual hearing and vision tests.
 TEACHER TRAINING & EDUCATION	ACHIEVING QUALITY Twenty four college units in early childhood education and development, sixteen general education units, and completes 21 hours of professional development annually.
 POSITIVE TEACHER – CHILD INTERACTION	HIGHEST QUALITY Scores higher on providing; emotional support; an organized classroom; consistent schedules and routines; interactions that build vocabulary, critical thinking skills and curiosity; lessons that include children's experiences and ideas.
 ENVIRONMENT	EXCEEDING QUALITY Scores high on providing: a safe, clean and enriching environment; good health practices; a variety of activities, materials, and play areas right for a child's age.
 TEACHER-CHILD RATIO	EXCEEDING QUALITY Three teachers for every twelve infants; two teachers for every ten toddlers; three teachers for every twenty four preschoolers or two teachers for every twenty preschoolers.
 DIRECTOR TRAINING & EDUCATION	HIGHEST QUALITY A master's degree with thirty college units in early childhood education and development, eight units of management/ administration, two units of supervision, and complete twenty one hours of professional development annually.
