CHILD OBSERVATION

HIGHEST QUALITY: Evaluates children's learning and development, holds parent conferences, and uses a state-approved tool to help children learn. Results are entered into a software program



HEALTH & CHILD DEVELOPMENT

ACHIEVING QUALITY: Ensures children receive annual vision and hearing tests, and checks to see if children are developing on track



TEACHER TRAINING & EDUCATION

HIGHEST QUALITY: A bachelor's degree in early childhood education and development and completes 21 hours of professional development annually
