 CHILD OBSERVATION	HIGHEST QUALITY: Evaluates children’s learning and development, holds parent conferences, and uses a state-approved tool to help children learn. Results are entered into a software program
 HEALTH & CHILD DEVELOPMENT	EXCEEDING QUALITY: Uses a form recommended by pediatricians to check children’s development, in addition to annual hearing and vision tests
 TEACHER TRAINING & EDUCATION	EXCEEDING QUALITY: An associate degree in early childhood education and development and completes 21 hours of professional development annually
 POSITIVE TEACHER – CHILD INTERACTION	EXCEEDING QUALITY: Scores high on providing: Emotional support; An organized classroom; Consistent schedules and routines; Interactions that build vocabulary, critical thinking skills and curiosity; Lessons that include children’s experiences and ideas
